Dear Fellow Member,

After careful consideration, the Board of Directors of BRRWSC has decided to relax the restrictions on water usage to Voluntary Use Restrictions Stage II. Even with the recent rains, the water level in the aquifers that supply our water have still not recovered from the drought, as it takes time for the rainfall to seep to the level of the aquifer. We are hopeful that continued rains over the next several weeks will provide sufficient replenishment and allow us to remove this restriction, but please be aware that continuation of drought conditions could require us to return to Stage III.

It is clear to the Board that the cooperation of the BRRWSC members has been very beneficial in helping us to maintain good levels of water in storage. Even though the Board of Directors of BRRWSC has determined it is still necessary to maintain conservation in our water usage by continuing with the Stage II water conservation measures for the next 60 days, we are all hopeful that we can soon return to normal. The board is looking at options for improving our well capabilities, but these improvements may take several months to be of benefit.

The text of the Stage II notice is enclosed on reverse side.

We ask each of you to help protect our dwindling water supply until such time as drought conditions ease. We have also been contacting those members that our equipment indicates have continuous usage over a 24-hour period, which usually indicates a leak of some sort, or perhaps a sprinkler left running. We appreciate your soonest attention to these notifications. Additionally, please follow the requirements listed in the notice, and we would like everyone to take a personal goal to continue to reduce their water usage wherever possible.

Thank you for continued patience and cooperation.

**NOTICE OF WATER RATIONING PROGRAM**  
February 18, 2020

**STAGE II (VOLUNTARY USE RESTRICTIONS)**

Because recent record conditions are predicted to continue well into 2020 and aquifer water levels are beginning to stabilize, we are lowering Restrictions to Stage II Voluntary Water Use Restrictions in the subdivision. You are accordingly notified of the following:

1. DATE RATIONING SHALL BEGIN: Thursday, February 18, 2020 at 12:00 midnight.
2. DATE RATIONING SHALL END: The period of rationing shall be for sixty (60) days. If underground aquifer levels improve due to rains, the period may be reduced in length. If the situation does not improve, more stringent rationing may be declared and the term extended. You will be advised in writing of changes in status.
3. STAGE AND EXPLANATION OF RATIONING: Stage II is hereby initiated because the drop in the water tables in the underground stratas caused by drought conditions has reduced the pumping capacity of the wells by greater than 30%. Members are requested to voluntarily limit the irrigation of landscape areas with hose-end sprinklers or automatic irrigation systems and to limit outdoor water use to the following schedule:

EVERY FIVE DAY USE: Members have been divided into five groups using the first letter of their last name and you may use water outdoors on the days designated for your Group.

|         |     |           |

| Group 1 | A-E | Monday    |
| Group 2 | F-J | Tuesday   |
| Group 3 | K-O | Wednesday |
| Group 4 | P-T | Thursday  |
| Group 5 | U-Z | Friday    |

Irrigation of landscaped areas is limited to the hours of 12:00 midnight until 8:00 AM and between 8:00 PM and 12:00 midnight on designated watering days. However, irrigation of landscaped areas is permitted at any time if is by means of a hand-held hose or a faucet filled bucket or watering can.

Your cooperation in this effort to conserve water is appreciated. Hopefully, rains will replenish aquifer levels and water restrictions won't have to shift to Stage III or IV.
